

Saint Mary's College Kalmanovitz School of Education Awards Scholarships to 27 Students

A total of twenty-seven students across all program areas were recognized during the 14th Annual Kalmanovitz School of Education Corporate Advisory Council Scholarship Dinner held at the Soda Center on May 14, 2008. Faculty and staff of the Kalmanovitz School of Education, members of its Corporate Advisory Council, and other donors were in attendance to honor students awarded scholarships. Opening and closing remarks were provided by Dave Cobo, this year's Corporate Advisory Council Chair. Saint Mary's College President Brother Ronald Gallagher, FSC, led the invocation. Dean Nancy Sorenson presented the awards assisted by members of the Corporate Advisory Council and donors, Associate Dean Mary Parish, and former School of Education Dean Fannie Preston.

About one-third of the students who applied this spring received an award.
