ARTICULATION AGREEMENT WITH CITY COLLEGE OF SAN FRANCISCO

General Education Transfer Equivalents at City College of San Francisco⁽¹⁾

A transfer student must present a record with a minimum of 23 transferable semester units and a minimum GPA of 2.3 for admission to Saint Mary's College.⁽²⁾ To transfer with junior status a student must have 60 or more UC transferable semester units. All courses must be passed with a grade of 'C-' or higher to be considered a transferable course. Students at Saint Mary's College of California are required to complete a minimum of 36 course credits (*approximately 120 units*) toward a Bachelor's Degree.⁽³⁾ The maximum number of units accepted from a community college is 64 semester units or 95 quarter units. All courses designated as UC transferable are transferable to Saint Mary's College of California.

- (1) Certification of the UC – IGETC is not required to transfer to Saint Mary's College of California. Students will have additional general education requirements to fulfill at Saint Mary's College in Collegiate Seminar, Religious Studies, and January Term. Students may follow the UC – IGETC with the following exceptions:
 - Area 1 – English Communication – 1C – Oral Communication not required.
 - Area 2 – Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning – Math 90,92, 97 and PSYC 5 do not meet the requirement.
 - Area 5 – Physical and Biological Sciences – ANTH 1, BIO 20,40, GEOL 11,18, IDST 9,10C, PHYC 40, 41, and PSYC 1B do not meet the requirement.
 - Area 6 – Language Other Than English – Complete through 3 or 3A+3B (or equivalent). See FOREIGN LANGUAGE section.
- (2) Saint Mary's College requires that students complete one year of high school algebra and one year of high school geometry or their equivalent with a grade of C or better before transfer. If these courses were not taken in high school or passed with a C or higher, Algebra - **MATH 90,92,840, or 860** and Geometry - **MATH 95,97, or 855** will fulfill the algebra and geometry requirements.
- (3) California Community College credits are accepted at the rate of 30 semester units = 45 quarter units = (9 course credits).

COLLEGIATE SEMINAR (4 courses, at least one per year at St. Mary's College)

The Collegiate Seminar program is central to the liberal arts education at Saint Mary's College. Transfer students must enroll in at least one seminar course, fall or spring term, for each year of attendance. In preparation for Collegiate Seminar we recommend that students take at least one course per year which emphasizes critical thinking, humanities, or cultural understanding.

THEOLOGY AND RELIGIOUS STUDIES (2 courses)

Students must complete two courses in religious studies the first being a lower division course and the second being upper division. Students entering with junior standing take only one religious studies course at Saint Mary's.

AREA REQUIREMENTS (6 courses)

Area Requirements (A,B,C) are part of the breadth requirement of the college. They may not be met by courses in a student's major discipline, but allied courses within the major may fulfill the requirement. **Courses taken beyond the Foreign Language requirement may be used to fulfill Area A (Humanities).***

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

The foreign language requirement can be fulfilled in the following ways:

CHIN 3 or 3A+3B	1. Three years of high school language grade 'B' or higher.
FREN 3 or 3A+3B GERM 3 or 3A+3B	2. Score of three or higher on an Advanced Placement Language examination.
ITAL 3A+3B	3. A passing score on the Saint Mary's College Language examination.
JAPA 3 or 3A+3B RUSS 3 or 3A+3B	4. A passing score on the TOEFL examination for international students.
SPAN 3 or 3A+3B	5. Completing courses through (3) in a language at City College of San Francisco.

*Courses taken beyond the Foreign Language requirement may be used to fulfill Area A (Humanities).

DIVERSITY REQUIREMENT (1 course)

<p>Students shall complete one course focused on the history, traditions, and/or culture(s) of a people or peoples of non-European origin.
