

Saint Mary's College of California ARTICULATION AGREEMENT WITH FOOTHILL COLLEGE



General Education Transfer Equivalents at Foothill College⁽¹⁾

A transfer student must present a record with a minimum of 23 transferable semester units and a minimum GPA of 2.3 for admission to Saint Mary's College.⁽²⁾ To transfer with junior status a student must have 60 semester or 90 quarter UC transferable units. All courses must be passed with a grade of 'C-' or higher to be considered a transferable course. Students at Saint Mary's College of California are required to complete a minimum of 36 course credits (*approximately 120 semester units*) toward a Bachelor's Degree.⁽³⁾ The maximum number of units accepted from a community college is 64 semester units or 95 quarter units. All courses designated as UC transferable are transferable to Saint Mary's College of California.

- (1) Certification of the UC – IGETC is not required to transfer to Saint Mary's College of California. Students will have additional general education requirements to fulfill at Saint Mary's College in Collegiate Seminar, Religious Studies, and January Term. Students may follow the UC - IGETC with the following exceptions:
 - Area 1 – English Communication – 1C – Oral Communication not required.
 - Area 2 – Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning – MATH 49 does not meet the requirement.
 - Area 3 – Arts and Humanities – PHOT 11 does not meet the requirement.
 - Area 5 – Biological and Physical Sciences – ANTH 1, GEOL 22, 25, HORT 10, OCEN 10, and PHYS 6,10,12 do not meet the requirement.
 - Area 6 – Language Other Than English -- Complete through 4 (or equivalent). See FOREIGN LANGUAGE section.

- (2) Saint Mary's College requires that students complete one year of high school algebra and one year of high school geometry or their equivalent with a grade of C or better before transfer. If these courses were not taken in high school or passed with a C or higher, Algebra - **MATH 101,103, or 105** and Geometry - **MATH 49, 51, or 102** will fulfill the algebra and geometry requirements.

- (3) California Community College credits are accepted at the rate of 30 semester units = 45 quarter units = (*9 course credits*).

COLLEGIATE SEMINAR (4 courses, at least one per year at St. Mary's College)

The Collegiate Seminar program is central to the liberal arts education at Saint Mary's College. Transfer students must enroll in at least one seminar course, fall or spring term, for each year of attendance. In preparation for Collegiate Seminar we recommend that students take at least one course per year which emphasizes critical thinking, humanities, or cultural understanding.

RELIGIOUS STUDIES (2 courses, one must be taken at St. Mary's College)

Students entering with junior standing take only one upper division Religious Studies course at Saint Mary's. The following courses will fulfill the lower division Religious Studies requirement at Saint Mary's.

AREA REQUIREMENTS (6 courses)

Area Requirements (A,B,C) are part of the breadth requirement of the college. They may not be met by courses in a student's major discipline, but allied courses within the major may fulfill the requirement. **Courses taken beyond the Foreign Language requirement may be used to fulfill Area A (Humanities).***

ENGLISH COMPOSITION (2 courses) Students who have not completed both composition courses will be required to take a placement examination. Those without satisfactory scores may need to enroll in a non-credit course and/or repeat first semester composition.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

The foreign language requirement can be fulfilled in the following ways:

CHIN 4	1. Three years of high school language grade 'B' or higher.
FREN 4	2. Score of three or higher on an Advanced Placement Language examination.
GERM 4	3. A passing score on the Saint Mary's College Language examination.
JAPN 4	4. A passing score on the TOEFL examination for international students.
KORE 4 SPAN 4	5. Completing courses through (4) in a language at Foothill College.

*Courses taken beyond the Foreign Language requirement may be used to fulfill Area A (Humanities).

DIVERSITY REQUIREMENT (1 course)

Students shall complete one course focused on the history, traditions, and/or culture(s) of a people or peoples of non-European origin. **Courses not listed in this section, but appear to meet the definition for this requirement, may be petitioned once a student enrolls at Saint Mary's College.**
