You will notice your program information on the top left, your GPA and more program information just below, and to the right, your progress bar towards completion. To search for a course, you may scroll down to view your requirements by course blocks, and select the course you wish to view sections for. In this example, we will scroll down to Section 2, and select ENGL-004.



After selecting ENGL-004, the Search for Courses and Course Sections will allow you to filter on your highlighted left side for certain criteria such as Subjects, Terms, Days of the Week, Time, and more. Once you have your filters set, you may select the highlighted "View Available Sections" just under the course listing. After finding the section you'd like to plan for, select "Plan Section" in blue to your right. You will have successfully completed this planned action when you receive a notification on your top right that the course is planned and ready to register.
