

The minor in Japanese Studies gives students language skills and cultural competencies for traveling and working in Japan.

The following lower-division courses are required for the minor unless students place directly into JAPAN 201 or higher.

## JAPAN 101 Beginning Japanese (4CU) JAPAN 102 Continuing Beginning Japanese (4CU) CORE: Arts and Humanities JAPAN 201 Intermediate Japanese (4CU) CORE: Global Issues and Perspectives

One conversation course and one culture course are required, courses may be repeated.

## JAPAN 110 (1CU) Basic Conversation or \*JAPAN 310 (1CU) Intermediate/advanced Conversation JAPAN 120 (1CU) Introduction to Japanese Culture or \*JAPAN 320 (1CU) Advanced Culture

Take at least 7 upper division units from the following:

- \*JAPAN 350 (1CU) Language Tutorial
- \*JAPAN 495 (1CU) Internship
- \*JAPAN 496 (1CU) Capstone
