


FACULTY WORKLOAD REFERENCE GUIDE





Before you begin



Teaching

If you have not yet talked with your chair about your teaching assignments for 2024-25 then you are not ready to complete the planning sheet.



Scholarship

Make sure that you are clear about the scholarship you have planned and what you can achieve in the AY24-25. You will need this info for the planning sheet.



Service

Make sure that you are clear about the service work (elections, etc) you have accepted, and other forms of service you plan to do in the AY24-25. You will need this info for the planning sheet.




Overview

Starting in AY2023-24, faculty will use a planning sheet to track their workload. The information you have already collected is entered in this planning sheet. This guide will help you learn how to complete that planning sheet.

The Workload planning sheet has been designed to make the process as easy as possible. You don't need to go from one form to another - notice that this planning sheet includes a section for each Workload category: Teaching, Service and Scholarship. The next pages will walk you through the use of the sheet.

Teaching

Insert the term, course number, course workload units (WU) and the course title into the Teaching section of the faculty workload planning sheet. The Carnegie units (CU) for the course are equivalent to the workload unit (WU).

The workload units will automatically calculate your total for you at the bottom of the section. For most faculty the total will fall within the 18-21 WU range.

Most faculty will have teaching workloads of 18-21 units. Faculty members who are planning for a year of significant service or scholarly activities will draw WUs from the teaching category.

There are some instances where the CU≠WU.



Service

Service to Teaching

In certain circumstances, full time faculty are granted additional WUs when their teaching work exceeds the Carnegie units for the course. These WUs are considered to be service to teaching units and should be recorded in the Service section of the workload planning sheet.

The full details of workload units for service are available on the Workload Implementation document



To identify the WUs for service, consult the Service Roles Reference List. SOLA service is on the SOLA tab, Senate committee work is listed on the Senate tab and core and advising service is on the Additional Service tab.

Scholarship

Consider your planned scholarly activity for 2024-2025 and declare yourself into a scholarship group A-F. Groups range from 'Staying Current (1wu) through to 'Exceptional Scholarship' (6wu)

Scholarship will typically fall in the range of 1-5 WUs.

They should be defined in your department's scholarship framing statement prepared for the Rank and Tenure Committee. Ask your chair for a copy.

SEBA faculty with "SA" designation per school criteria or who are working toward "SA" designation per school criteria should declare themselves to be in Group E.
