As a Lasallian college, Saint Mary's holds that students are given to its care by God and that teachers grow spiritually and personally when their work is motivated by faith and zeal. A distinctive mark of a Lasallian school is its awareness of the consequences of economic and social injustice and its commitment to the poor. 





Appendix

LIST OF GRADUATES

The preceding list of graduates and their degrees is based on information supplied by the various program offices. Although every effort was made to ensure that the information was correct at the time the booklet went to press, a student's status may change after that date. Graduation status, degree completion, and academic honors are subject to a final degree-requirements evaluation. The posting of the earned degree on the official transcript record in the Registrar's Office remains the official testimony of the possession of the degree.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic regalia worn by today's college professors links them with their counterparts in the medieval universities. Caps and gowns were standard daily attire for educated persons as early as the twelfth century and undoubtedly evolved from the robes, hoods, and caps worn for warmth in the frigid stone abbeys by the monks and friars who were the early students and masters.

The traditional cap is the mortarboard ornamented with a black tassel or, in the case of a doctor's cap, a gold tassel. A number of colleges and universities specify a soft velvet tam instead of the stiff mortarboard in their academic attire.

The academic hood hangs down the back of the gown, denoting the field of study of the wearer and the university awarding the degree. The inner satin lining represents the colors of the university awarding the degree, and the upper trim's colors represent the School awarding the degree.

New graduates of Saint Mary's College wear colored hoods representing their school. Banners decorating the stage area reflect the colors of the schools:

- Economics and Business Administration, Drab
- Education, Light Blue
- Liberal Arts, White
- Science, Gold

Members of the governing body of a college or university, whatever their degrees may be, are entitled to wear doctor's gowns. They may also wear a hood representing the institution they govern, rather than that from which they hold a degree.
