## **Purpose of a Mission Statement**

A mission statement explains why your organization exists and what it seeks to achieve. It should:

- State your *purpose and goals*
- Reflect your values and philosophy
- Describe what you do and who you serve

## **Key Questions to Guide You**

When drafting, ask yourselves:

- 1. Who are we? (Who do we represent?)
- 2. What do we value? (What principles guide us?)
- 3. What do we do? (What activities or aims define us?)
- 4. How do we do it? (What approaches or strategies do we use?)

## **Writing Tips**

- Collaborate: Invite input from members and advisors.
- **Be concise:** Aim for 3–5 clear sentences.
- Learn from others: Review sample statements, but make yours unique.
- Revise thoughtfully: Draft, refine, and revisit until it feels right.
- Share widely: Post on your website, social media, and promotional materials.
