The 2015-2016 Fact Book highlights some impressive accomplishments for the College. For example, the 2015 entering freshmen class is the largest since 2010 and has the highest average high school GPA (3.64) on record. The proportion of traditional undergraduates that is minority (non-white) is a record-high 48.7 percent, with the graduate student figure of 38.2 percent also a record high. And the number of bachelor's degrees awarded in 2014-15 (759) continued to set new highs. (Login required)
