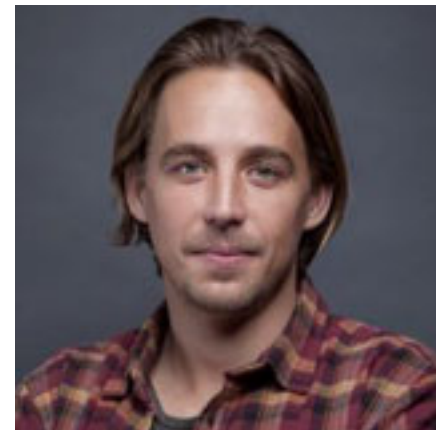
2016 Commencement Speakers Named
