Men's Rugby Wins Championship for Third Time



In the fifth consecutive D1A Rugby National Championship meeting between the two schools, [Saint Mary's men's rugby team defeated Life University 30-24](#) at SMC Stadium Saturday. The Gaels' third D1A title breaks the deadlock between SMC and Life, with All-American fullback Dylan Audsley '17 (right with ball, Austen Middleton '17 on the left) accounting for 25 points. The women's rugby team also finished strong, winning the West Coast Conference Plate Championship 33-12 in March and competing in the National Small College Rugby Organization 7s championship for the first time in April.
