President's Address to the SMC Community

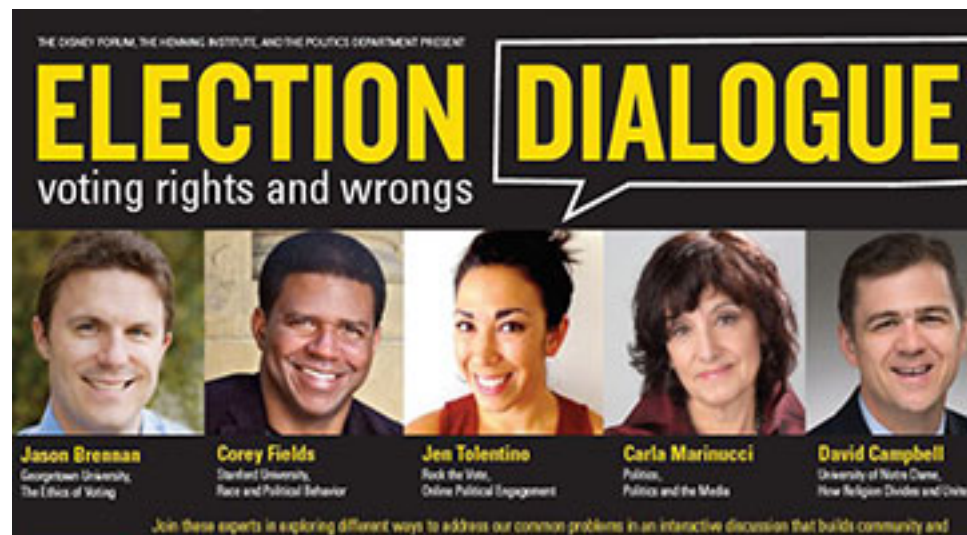
