As the California minimum wage increases to \$10 an hour effective Jan. 1, [Saint Mary's has updated its student employment wage scale](#). Student wages will increase to the new rates based upon students' current Level and Step classifications effective Jan. 1, 2016. The College increased departments' student wage budgets this year by 5 percent to account for the increase.
