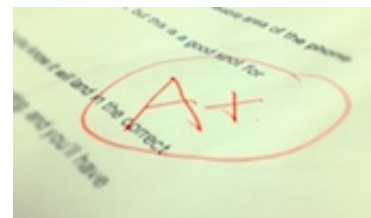
SF Business Times Names Provost Beth Dobkin Among Bay Area's Most Influential Women

Campus Cal Grant Roundtable



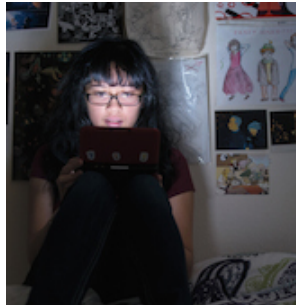
