More than 52 percent of the incoming class identify as students of color and 10 percent graduated from Lasallian high schools.

Saint Mary's has had a strong showing recently in annual college ranking lists. The College was listed among the top 10 regional universities in the West in the 2016 edition of Best Colleges by *U.S. News & World Report*. SMC was also named one of the top 380 colleges by *Princeton Review* last month, as well as a top return on investment school by *Business Insider* and Payscale last year for undergraduate business programs.
