College's Net Assets at Record Level



Recently released financial statements show that Saint Mary's continues to improve its financial position, said Vice President for Finance Pete Michell. Total net assets increased by \$3.5 million to \$239.6 million this year, setting a record for total net assets, the highest since the pre-recession high of \$223.9 million on June 30, 2007. 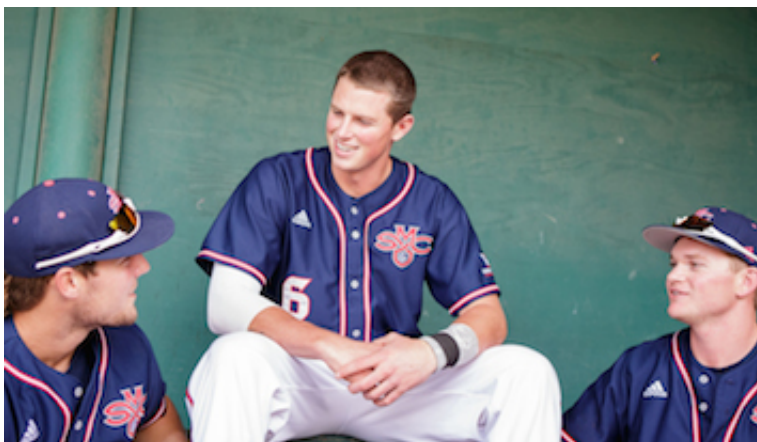
