Trustees Approve Changes to Budget

The Saint Mary's Board of Trustees approved changes to the College's operating budget for the 2015-2016 fiscal year at its annual fall meeting Oct. 15. The approved changes reflect a \$1.8 million or 1.4 percent reduction in total operating budget revenues to \$128.7 million, primarily due to changes in net tuition revenue.

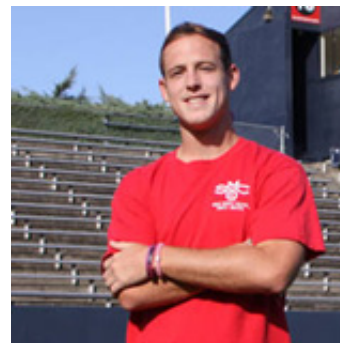

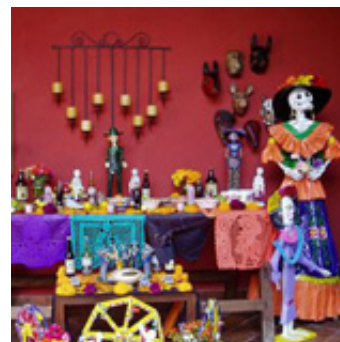
Tesla Motors CIO on Revolutionary Car Company
