### COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT (CE) COURSES

All Saint Mary's students will take at least one course that meets the community engagement component of the core curriculum. CILSA staff and student leaders support students, faculty, and local non-profits and schools in making this happen. Students learn about CE courses from their advisor; CE courses are identified during course registration.

### PAID OPPORTUNITIES

**Jumpstart Corps Members** serve in teams to implement curriculum twice a week that helps preschool children develop the language and literacy skills they need to be ready for kindergarten (1 year commitment, 10-12 hours per week) **HIRING FWS students:** [www.jstart.org/APPLY](http://www.jstart.org/APPLY)



**Monument Corps for Middle School School Success** student leaders recruit and lead teams of students to partner with De La Salle Middle School to plan and implement academic and enrichment programming for youth. (1 year commitment, 5-8 hours per week)



**Engaged Learning Facilitators** assist faculty, students and community partners in course-based community engagement. (1 year commitment, 5-10 hours per week)

### CREDIT BEARING OPPORTUNITIES

**MICAH Summer Fellowship** students live together in community and work full time at a non-profit organization in the San Francisco Bay Area and Tijuana, Mexico. (June and July, full-time; includes housing, food, transportation and a stipend)



**Public Service Internship** students are unpaid interns (8-10 hours/week) at Bay Area non-profits big and small, city governments, and any type of entity that would fall under the notion of "public service." The internship also includes an academic component during which students explore theories of change, organizational theory, vocational exploration, and topics related to each student's field of study. (Fall semester only, includes a stipend)

**January Term Courses:** This coming year staff will teach a leadership and peacemaking immersion course to Rwanda, as well as an intercultural communication course on campus.
