- BA/BS required for credential and master's programs, plus a master's for the doctoral program
- BA completion program requires 64 UC transferable units and 3–5 years of work experience
- GPA: 2.8 or better; 3.5 for Ed.D.
- Tests—teaching credential: CBEST/CSET; Ed.D.: GRE or MAT
- Tier I Credential—5 years experience + Clear credential
- MA in Leadership—BA/BS + 3–5 years professional experience
