INTRAMURAL SPORTS/LEAGUES RULES: OUTDOOR SOCCER

TEAM REQUIREMENTS:

- A team will consist of a maximum of 7 players on the field at one time, including goalie.
- A minimum of 3 players are required to start a game.
- A minimum of 2 females must be on the field at all times.

EQUIPMENT:

- Athletic shoes must be worn at all times.
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- Cleats are allowed, but no metal cleats.
- No jewelry.
- No big hair clips.
- Shin guards are encouraged but not required.
- Pennies must be worn at all times.
 - Players must show SMC or state ID in order to get a penny and for verification that they are on the roster.

GAME RULES:

- Game time is start time.
- Two 20 minute halves, 5 minute halftime.
- Rock, paper, scissors for possession of ball for kick-off.
- Game clock is a “running clock”.
- Game clock will stop for 2 final minutes at the end of the second half for any time the ball is out of bounds or there is a stop in the play.
 - This rule will only take place if one team is up by only 2 or less goals.
- Offside will be called to the best of the referee’s ability.
- Games will go on a point system:
 - 3 points for a win/forfeit win
 - 1 point for a tie
 - 0 points for a loss
 - -1 points for a forfeit loss
- Substitutions made during a game can be made during any stopped play.

TIE BREAKERS/OVERTIME:

- Rock, paper, scissors is played for possession of ball.
- First team to score in overtime wins.
- Overtime = 5 minutes of golden goal.
- If neither team scores game ends in tie.

PENALTIES:

**Penalties range from removal of player for a set time to ejection of player. CampusRec Supervisor and Officials have final say over matter.*

- No slide tackling.
- Hand balls are called if intentional or give advantage. One re-do per throw-in before ball is turned over to the other team.
- Hand ball in the goalie box = indirect kick.
- 10 yards of courtesy on corner kick.
- No excessive aggressiveness.
- No profanity. Players who use profanity on the court will have an immediate ejection from the game. No exceptions. Must talk with Andrew DeMaria and Phil DeTonnancourt.
- Free kicks take place at the place of penalty.
- 1 yellow card = 3 minutes off the field, cannot come on to the field again until told to do so by referee. Player cannot be substituted.
- 2 yellow cards/1 red card = sit out rest of game, must talk to Andrew DeMaria and Phil DeTonnancourt.
- No food on the turf - only water
