**Get Paid While you Work on Your Credential!**

Need to get paid while you work on your credential? With an internship, you are employed full-time in a classroom while working towards your credential. Some of the state requirements for this program include: subject matter competency, meeting the U.S. Constitution requirement, and an offer of employment (which you secure). Better yet, you have the benefit of doing your student teaching in your own classroom!

**Program Requirements:**

- **Subject Matter Competence (CSET)**
- **U.S. Constitution**
- **CBEST**
- **Offer of Employment**
- **Admission to the Kalmanovitz School of Education**
- **(120) hours of instruction covering (5) specified areas**

Students who work under an internship credential (Special Education, Multiple Subject, or Single Subject) may be eligible for a support program through the Contra Costa County of Education. The program includes mentor support and money for the student and his/her mentor.

Interested students should check with the district in which the internship would reside to see if it is eligible for this program.
