SMC Supports ACCU Position on Executive Order

President James Donahue is presently in Washington, D.C., attending the annual meeting of the Association of Catholic Colleges and Universities (ACCU). In light of President Trump's executive order on travel bans, [the ACCU has issued a statement in opposition to that order](#). The college and university presidents attending the meeting, including President Donahue, have supported the ACCU statement. Based on current information, Saint Mary's does not anticipate problems for groups traveling during Jan Term or for our students studying abroad. However, we are aware of at least one graduate student who has traveled abroad and whose return may be impacted by the order. We are endeavoring to provide resources we have available to support that student.

Mahershala Ali Collects Awards and Nominations



Mahershala Ali '96, who launched his acting career right here at Saint Mary's, won two Screen Actors Guild awards yesterday ([watch his moving acceptance speech](#)) and was nominated for an Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor for his role in *Moonlight* last week. Ali, who delivered the 2016 undergraduate Commencement address, has also starred in *Hidden Figures*, *Luke Cage*, and *House of Cards*. The 2017 Academy Awards ceremony is Feb. 26.

New 2016-2017 Fact Book

The 2016-2017 Fact Book highlights some impressive achievements for the College. A wealth of institutional information is available only online, including student success outcomes where the latest fall freshman entrant four-year graduation rate for underrepresented minorities is at a historical high (65.8 percent) and exceeds the overall cohort rate. In addition, the latest fall freshman entrant six-year graduation rate (72.2 percent for both underrepresented minorities and all other freshman entrants) is an all-time high. Diversity for the first-year entering fall freshman class of 2020 remains strong at 51.6 percent of students of color.
