Required first-semester courses for students interested in the *Dance: Choreography and Performance* major or *Dance minor*:

Fall 2019 all students must take:

1. Perfa 080, Dance Science (T/Th 1:15-2:50)
2. Each dancer also takes two .25 Dance Technique classes
 - Perfa 075-01, Dance Co. I: Ballet (M/W/F 11:45-12:50)
 - Perfa 75-02, Dance Co I; Modern/Contemporary (T/Th 11:30-1:05)

Auditions: The Saint Mary's College Dance Company will hold auditions the first week of classes for the Company and the Fall performance. Company auditions are September 3rd in the Rec Center Dance Studio from 11:30-1:05 with a modern dance class, and September 4th from 11:45-12:50 with a ballet class in Syfy Dance Studio.
