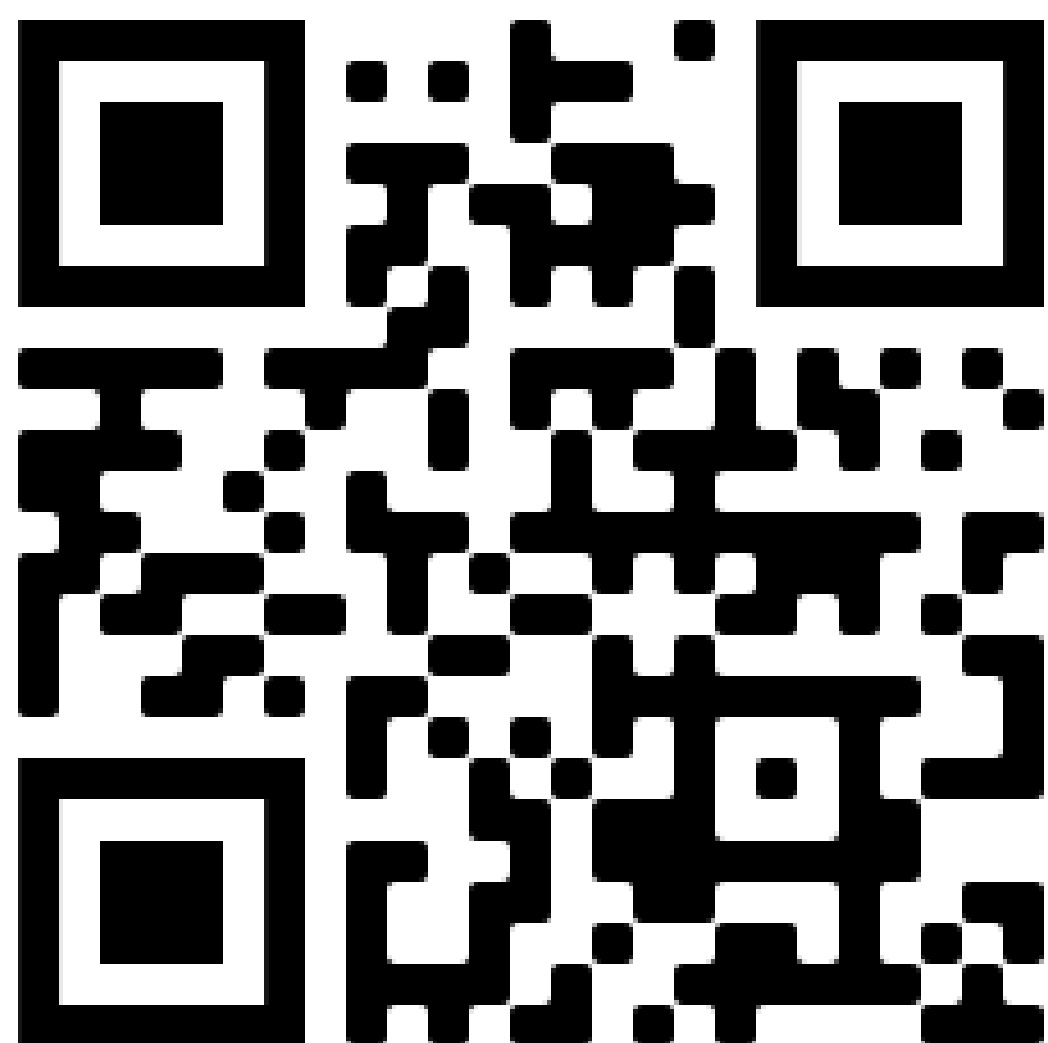


WHAT IS DISCORD?

ABOUT OUR SERVER

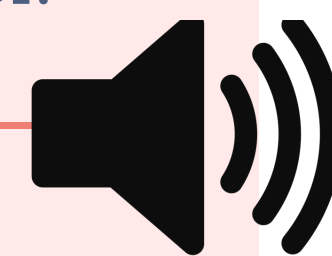

JOIN OUR DISCORD SERVER

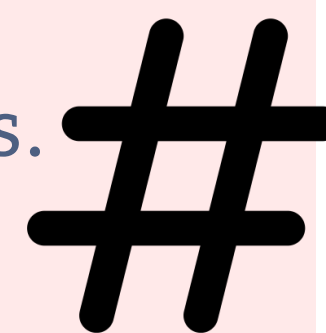
USING DISCORD

First, you'll need to register for an account on discord.com. If you are a student org exec team member or participated in our involvement fair you should have already done this. Then be sure to join our server using the QR code in the bottom left. If you participated in the involvement fair, you're already a member of our channel.



Voice channels: Voice channels are marked with a speaker symbol. If you click this channel, you will be connected to a live audio call with anyone available on that channel.

Text Channels: Text channels are marked with a hashtag symbol. If you click on a text channel, you can type messages and attach files.
